HELP THE POOR

Christ is teaching us today that it is good and wonderful to keep the commandments but not enough to keep just the commandments so as to make heaven. We need to give alms to the poor. Though, Jesus is not condemning riches, only the selfish accumulation of riches. It is not a sin to be rich, but the sin lies in being rich alone. We must learn how to be generous and sympathetic. We must use our little resources for the good of all. This young man in the gospel of today left Christ angrily because he didn't want to share his wealth with anybody. No wonder Christ told His disciples "How difficult it is for those who trust in money to enter into the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God". So, the real problem here does not lie on possessing wealth but on one's wrong attitude towards wealth. Material possessions if not carefully used can make one run into the tendency of fixing his heart solely on the things of this world. Material possessions make one to think of only money and what money can buy. It is good for us to understand very well today that whatever we have no matter how small or big is given to us by God and for the good of others. Be that as it may, we can say that the great wealth of this young man could represent our possessions, money, land, property, foodstuffs, talents etc which we often consider more important than Jesus. Hence, the Lord's demand to each of us is "Go, sell all you own, give the money to the poor and come follow me". So don't be afraid to help the poor for Jesus says that "there is no one who has left house, brothers, sisters, father, children or land for my sake and for the sake of the gospel who will not be repaid a hundred times over, houses, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and land-not without persecutions-now in this present time and, in the world to come, eternal life" I wish you a blessed Sunday.
