Sometime last week I went shopping, as I was coming out of the shop, I noticed a little boy of about eight years giving a beggar who was sitting beside the entrance of the shop a bottle of coke and a pack of biscuit and dropped some coins inside his begging bag. I was delighted and amazed. I simply with joy in my heart gave this little boy thumbs up. This demonstrates that giving is not exclusively for the rich and great, but everyone is meant to give; rich and poor alike; old and young; great and small. It is in giving that we receive. It is a beautiful thing to give no matter how small because it is not how much we give that matters but the heart that gives. Two widows are presented to us in the first reading and Gospel of today who had almost nothing but from the little they had they still gave. They gave from the little they had and yet did not lack.
