BE HUMBLE AND YOU WILL BE EXALTED!!!

The word HUMILITY is from a Latin word humus which simply means soil. It reminds us of what we say on Ash Wednesday that “dust you are and unto dust you shall return”. This means that life is full of emptiness and as such we all are called upon to stay humble. Jesus is teaching us today not to be prideful but be humble and simple. We are called upon to learn from Him for He says that “the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many” (Mark 10:45). Again, He told His Disciples “Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all” (Mark 10:43).

Unfortunately, today, people are scrambling for first position, high status, and excess wealth and as such exhibit a high level of arrogance and aggression, pride and self-righteousness. Pride, they say, goes before a fall and the book of Sirach says that “there is no cure for the proud man’s malady, since an evil growth has taken root in him” (3:28). Little wonder Jesus warns that “everyone who exalts himself will be humbled”. So, be humble lest you stumble. Humility makes us to help those who are in need: the Poor, the Crippled, the blind and the Lame. Sincere humility involves showing love and identifying with the less privileged thus it attracts but lack of it detracts. Let’s take this home “the greater you are, the more you should behave humbly, and then you will find favour with the Lord” (Sirach 3:18). Thus, Jesus says “the man who humbles himself will be exalted” (Luke 14:11). Be humble and you will be exalted!!! I wish you a lovely Sunday!!!
