INCREASE OUR FAITH!!!

Many people today in the world are angry with God; they blame God for watching and keeping quiet over the atrocities happening in the world. Some even boldly say that God does not exist that even if He exists, He must be a weak God because He can't be keeping quiet over injustices in the world; the poor are being marginalized by the rich and denied their right. As a result of this, so many people have abandoned their faith because for them God does not help neither does He save.

Habakkuk in the first reading encountered this kind of situation and he asks, "How long, O Lord, am I to cry for help while you will not listen; to cry 'Oppression!' in your ear and you will not save?" (Hab 1:2) But there is God, and He does His things His own way and at His own time. Thus, God answered Habakkuk by encouraging him not to give up his faith. Interestingly he never lost his faith. He says "...Though the olive crop fails, and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Saviour" (Hab 3:17). Despite all odds, Habakkuk didn't lose his faith for he believed that "the upright man will live by his faithfulness" (Hab. 2:4). Little wonder the disciples asked Jesus to "increase our faith". Faith is a gift that helps us to understand life and brings us happiness. We need to pray today and ask God to increase our faith so as to face and surmount all the temptations, difficulties and problems in life without giving up. I encourage you today to keep to your faith, don't lose hope for "only those who persevere till the end will be saved" (Mt 24:13). Don't worry! There is God and He is solely in charge of everything. I wish you a blessed Sunday!!!
