### BE THANKFUL!!!

Ten lepers were in dire need of help unfortunately, no one was there to help them. They were very desperate in their situation because virtually everyone avoided them because of their contagious sickness. In this state of desperation, they met Jesus and begged Him "Jesus! Master! Take pity on us". Moved by compassion Jesus told them to "Go and show yourselves to the priests". They left immediately and while still on the way they got healed. Having seen themselves well again, nine of them went on their way not minding to go back to say thank you. Only one among the ten realized the necessity of gratitude. He went back with joy and threw himself at the feet of Jesus and thanked Him. Jesus was not happy with the other nine and said "were not all ten made clean? The other nine, where are they? Sometimes we behave like these nine people; we take for granted favours done to us.
