THERE IS LIGHT AT THE END OF THE TUNNEL!!!

Dear Friends!!! It is the fourth Sunday of Lent otherwise known as LAETARE SUNDAY. This name came from the entrance antiphon of the day taken from Isaiah 66:10-11 which says "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exalt and be satisfied at her consoling breast". The Church today encourages us in our Lenten observances by inviting us to look ahead towards the joy of Easter. It takes the person of faith to be happy in the midst of difficult and painful circumstances. It is only faith that can give one the conviction that there is light at the end of the tunnel. In the first reading of today we can see the Jews passing through a very difficult moment in exile that led them to sing this song "By the rivers of Babylon there we sat and wept (Ps 137).

However, when it seemed that all hope was lost, God raised from nowhere King Cyrus of Persia, who not only released them from exile but also helped them to rebuild their Temple.

Just as it was with the people of Israel in the desert who were devastated because of snake bites as a result of their sins. In their pain and frustration, they appealed to God through Moses. God showed His mercy and asked Moses to make a fiery serpent and raise it as a standard, so that anyone beaten by the snake will look up to it and survive (Num 21:8). Now, Jesus came and replaced this fiery serpent with Himself on the cross 'so that everyone who believes may have eternal life' (Jn 3:14). Thus, our salvation rests on the cross!!! Therefore, are you depressed? Are you in pains? Are you struggling with one particular sin or the other? Are you finding it difficult to forgive and let go? Are you at the verge of losing your faith? Are you finding it extremely hard to pray? Is life treating you unfairly? Don't give up for there is light at the end of the tunnel. Look up to the cross and receive

So, no matter what you are passing through now don't lose your joy. In your pains, look up to Jesus on the cross and receive joy and restoration. Jesus is lifted on the cross to give us salvation. I wish you a holy and spirit filled Lenten season!!!
