FROM CHEER TO JEER

Dear Friends, it is Palm Sunday also known as Passion Sunday. It is a day the Church commemorates the triumphal entry of our Lord Jesus Christ into Jerusalem. The Gospel accounts made us to understand that our Lord Jesus rode into the city on a donkey amidst cheers from the crowds. They were spreading their clothes and palm olives and shouting Hosanna, but unfortunately, turned later to shout, 'crucify him'. They changed from cheer to jeer; from shouting hosanna to crucify him. Therefore, as we step into the Holy Week, we have to ask ourselves these pertinent questions:

Am I that kind of Christian who derives joy in going to Church when things are going well for me and curse God and the Church when difficulties and problems come? Do I derive joy in mocking an innocent victim just like the soldiers did? Do I have my individual opinion to issues, or do I join the crowd not minding whether they are right or wrong just like the crowd that changed from praise to cajoling? Have I known the right thing to do and refused to do it for fear of doing the right thing will cost me my positions of power and privilege just like Pilate? Do I find it difficult to acknowledge my sins and repent of my sinful ways just like the unrepentant thief on the cross? Have I shied away from my faith and denied Christ in my working place or before my friends as Peter did? Have I betrayed a friend just like Judas did to his master? On a positive note, Can I help those who are in need just like Simon of Cyrene? Can I show love and compassion to those suffering just like the women of Jerusalem? Can I respect the body of Christ just like Joseph of Arimathea? Can I adore and protect the body of Christ just like Mary of Magdala and Mary the mother of Joset? Finally, can I repent of my sinful ways just like the repentant thief on the cross? So, as we resolve to follow Christ to Jerusalem this Holy week, may we die with Him on the cross so as to resurrect with Him on Easter morning as holy and wonderful Christians. Amen.
