"TAKE ALL THIS OUT OF HERE!!!"

Hello Friends!!! It is the third Sunday of Lent. We have gone half way into the 40 days spiritual journey with our Lord. I believe you are doing well with your Lenten observances. Just to encourage you to keep on striving towards being a better and wonderful Christian. In the Gospel of this 3rd Sunday of Lent, Jesus went into the temple and found people buying and selling. He was indignant and made a whip out of some cord and chased them out of the temple. He says, "Take all this out of here and stop turning my Father's house into a market" (Jn 2:16). The people wanted to understand more why He did what He did by asking Him for a sign and He says, "Destroy this sanctuary, and in three days I will raise it up" (Jn 2:20). The Jews thought He was talking about the building but "he was speaking of the sanctuary that was his body" (Jn 2:21). This simply means that Jesus Christ is the temple of God and if Christ is the temple of God, we are the body of Christ as St Paul says in 1 Corinthians 12:27 and if we are the body of Christ, definitely we are the temple of God. Hence, St Paul asks "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?" (1 Cor. 6:19-20). So, you and I are the temples of God, and the temple of God should be kept neat and holy. Thus, Jesus says 'take all this out of here'. We all are called upon in this Lenten season to take away every rubbish of greed, anger, unforgiveness, lust, pride, spiritual sloth, selfishness and jealousy from the temple of God and make it clean and holy. The best way to achieve this is to follow and keep the commandments of God as laid down in the book of Exodus. Remember, the commandments are not given to us to punish us by God or to limit our freedom but given to us out of love for us to follow so as to make eternal life. Little wonder Jesus summarised the commandments into love of God and love of neighbour. Love and you have fulfilled the law (Rm 13:10). I wish you a holy and spirit filled Lenten season!!! FR BEDE
