

The Psalmist in Psalm 24:1-2 says that "The Lord is the earth and its fullness, the world and all who live there; it is he who laid its foundations on the seas, on the flowing waters fixed it firm" Thus, God created the world and blessed it with super abundant resources that will be more than enough for everyone. 


